3. Take the Lamrim teachings as your core practice.

A kangso puja is performed monthly to invoke the blessings of the Dharma Protectors. 'Kang' means 'to fulfil' and 'so' means 'to offer', hence a kangso is also known as a fulfilment ritual.

In the presence of the Dharma Protectors, we make offerings and requests, as well as confess our downfalls. Dharma Protectors in return keep their promise to protect us on the path towards enlightenment.
